At Outwood Academy Danum we take our responsibility to protect the wellbeing and health of students and staff very seriously.

We have a large number of students and staff in school with asthma. Asthma is a lung condition that can cause breathing difficulties. Individuals with asthma can be sensitive to various triggers which can lead to a life threatening asthma attack.

A trigger for many individuals with asthma is aerosols such as deodorant, aftershave, perfume or hairspray. In order to safeguard staff and students we are asking that students not to spray aerosols within the Academy; this includes the PE area. There will therefore be a ban on bringing aerosols in to the Academy.

As from 4<sup>th</sup> June 2018 this will be enforced and students who are caught spraying aerosols in the Academy will be given an hours detention after school.
