Dear Parent/Carer

Timetable arrangements for Year 11 from Monday 11th June 2018

As you will be aware, your son/daughter is in the middle or nearing the end of their GCSE examinations, working hard in school to access as much support as possible in order to do his/her very best.

It is a genuine pleasure to see Year 11 working in master-classes in the subjects that are a priority for them, completing revision for those subjects where they still have an examination.

I am sure you are as proud of your son/daughter as we are. Outwood Academy Danum is developing an impressive culture of learning, in part down to the hard work, focus and commitment shown by our year 11 students.

I write to give you a brief overview of how your son/daughter's timetable will look from Monday 11th June and to outline arrangements for their remaining time within the academy. Each student also has a personalised timetable showing remaining exams, masterclasses and when to attend. The Department of Education set an official leaving date for year 11 students, which is 29th June 2018. It is important that students attend and complete master classes unless signed out of the academy with all exams completed before this date.

| Thurs 14th June | Spanish Speaking and Listening exam . Physics or statistics master classes. Panjabi Exam . Some students will have study leave at 12.30pm please refer to your son's/ daughter's personalised timetable. |

Fri 15th June

Physics 2 Exam. German master classes. **Polish exam.**

Where students have completed all of their GCSE exams they will be signed out of school at 11.30am please refer to your son's/ daughter's personalised timetable.

Parents and staff will know if a student has completed all of their GCSE exams because they will have a form signed by Mrs Gray giving them permission to go home. We ask parents to note if their son/ daughter has a signed form and to make suitable arrangements. Please also ensure that students with some exams remaining continue to attend master classes.

Mon 18th June

German Speaking and Listening exam. Panjabi exam. Arabic exam. Statistics and Hair and Beauty master classes.

Tues 19th June

Hair and Beauty exam. Statistics and German master classes.
Russian exam. Greek exam.

Wed 20th June

Polish exam. Arabic exam. Statistics and German master classes.

Thurs 21st June

German exam. Statistics exam. Remaining students will be signed out of school once these exams are completed. Some students studying both German and statistics have an exam clash. This means they will be supervised at the end of their German exam, whilst having a break and then sit the statistics exam.

Fri 22nd June

Greek Exam.

Please note that students must follow their intervention timetables, which highlight their personalised master classes, and attend all examinations.
